START SURVEY

No patient or family member with respiratory infection or suspected respiratory infection should be admitted to the Cancer Center. The patient should be oriented by his/her physician via telephone or videoconference.

Patients with appointment will be attended, patients without appointments not be received.

Constant communication will be maintained with your treating physicians to coordinate dates and time for chemotherapy infusions, with the aim of maintaining a maximum of 8 simultaneous infusions. This means that we may move some patients' infusions a day or two.

Group sessions **are suspended** for an indefinite period of time.

Catheter cleansing will **be suspended**

Family access is reduced to one person only with first-time patients.

Protocols for entry



Hands must be washed or disinfected upon entering the facility.



Do not shake hands, kiss, or hug.



When coughing cover yourself with the inside of your elbow.



Use facemask properly.
